In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?

**Broker Statement** 

Mr. Nowak vehemently denies the customers' allegations. All of the material features and risks of the subject fixed annuity and real estate investment trust -- specifically including restrictions on liquidity and the time horizon for each -- were fully disclosed to the customers in writing, and the customers acknowledged their understanding of same, in writing. The subject investments were entirely suitable for the customers, based on their stated investment objectives, needs and other aspects of the customers' investor profiles. In addition, the customers' have not incurred any losses or damages on either product.

The clients did received dividends for the last six years, received statements showing non traded estimated share price, acknowledging dollar amount of dividends paid and that they intentionally reinvested to purchase shares of the same non traded REIT with the dividends the entire six years. That option could have been changed at any time to have dividends redirected to them at any time but elected not to from inception of their purchase. They were a knowledgeable, involved, informed participants and received required legal materials for the REIT annually that brought the status of the REIT to their attention regularly and never had any complaint with the dividend amount or the reinvestment of dividends.
