BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.
- How current is this information?
- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

Broker Statement

I worked with the [REDACTED] from 2017 to 2022. We did thorough financial planning, and I helped them retire. We had a great working relationship during that time. As their fiduciary, I was compensated through management fees, not commission. We purchased the GWG bond in November 2022 as a two-year holding for our fixed income portfolio, after months of research. The purchase, done in their Charles Schwab brokerage IRAs, represented approximately 4% of the account. We did not receive a commission. In fact, we purchased the bond at a discount to par to pass the savings on to the client. The issues with GWG that eventually led to their bankruptcy were not disclosed to us by GWG in our due diligence. It was also approved by several larger broker dealers at the time.



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
